




# FIPA FELLOWSHIP IN IPA

The **IPA Fellowship in Podiatry & Diabetic Foot Care** is a distinguished recognition awarded to medical professionals who have demonstrated outstanding commitment, clinical excellence, and leadership in the prevention, diagnosis, and management of diabetic foot conditions. This Fellowship acknowledges achievements in clinical practice, academic contributions, research, and community service, and seeks to promote the highest standards of podiatric care in India.

## 1. Essential Eligibility Criteria

#### 1.1 IPA Membership

 Must be an active IPA member for a minimum of 3 consecutive years, with membership dues paid up to date.

## 1.2 Speciality Interest & Focus

- Demonstrated, documented interest in **podiatry and diabetic foot care**.
- Active participation in clinical work related to diabetic foot care as part of regular medical practice.

#### 1.3 Clinical Engagement

- At least **5 years of active clinical involvement** in the management of diabetic patients, including regular diabetic foot assessments and treatment.
- Must be actively seeing diabetic patients in clinical practice on a routine basis (minimum: average of 20 diabetes consultations per month or equivalent patient load).
- Should maintain **documented clinical records** related to diabetic foot management.

## 2. Nomination Process

- Candidates must be nominated by the core executive body of their State IPA Chapter.
- Nominations must be formally submitted by the President, Secretary, or Vice
   President of the Chapter, along with supporting documentation

## 3. Selection Procedure

- The **IPA Fellowship Committee** will review all applications against the eligibility criteria.
- Shortlisted candidates may be contacted for clarification or additional documentation.
- Final selection will be based on a holistic evaluation of clinical contributions, academic work, SOP, and service to the community

# 4. Fellowship Tenure & Renewal

- Fellowship validity: **3 years** from the date of conferment.
- Renewal requires:
  - a. Submission of a renewal application with evidence of ongoing clinical involvement in diabetic foot care.
  - b. Proof of continued CPD activities.
- Failure to apply for renewal will result in automatic lapse of fellowship status.

- Use of the title "Fellow of the Indian Podiatry Association (FIPA)" in professional communications.
- Priority access to IPA conferences, workshops, and training events.
- Eligibility to serve as faculty in IPA programs and represent IPA at national and international platforms.
- Inclusion in the official **IPA Fellowship Directory**.
